QUEEN MARY'S GARDENS

Queen Mary's Gardens was originally used as a plant nursery while the park was under development as a residential estate. It was then sold out by Harcourt and Borton as the Gardens of the Royal Botanic Society of London until dissolved in 1932 and much of the original structure remains.

Buses are not the only treasure of the Gardens. The Octagonum border has 14 National Collection status. The Mediterranean Borders are well established and the Regent's Garden is twice yearly planted with seasonal bedding. Showers are an elegantly designed and located to add a sense of mystery and privacy to the Gardens.
